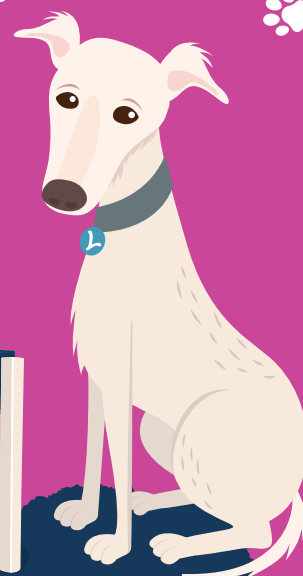


# YOUR GUIDE TO GREYHOUND & LURCHER CARE

Greyhounds are one of the oldest known breeds, historically owned exclusively by nobility, while Lurchers are often a mix of sighthounds and other breeds, making each one unique.

## DO THEY MAKE GOOD PETS?

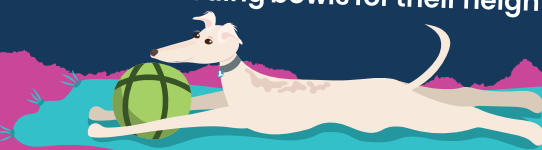
Absolutely! Greyhounds are gentle, polite, and great with children – Although, as with all dogs, youngsters need to learn to respect their space.
